What is LUKE?

LUKE is a multilateral initiative by EU Member States and Horizon Europeassociated countries to strengthen Ukraine's research and innovation (R&I) ecosystem.

Key objectives:

- To organise a joint call for proposals to fund transnational R&I projects with Ukrainian participation.
- To enhance the country's scientific capacities.

Why is LUKE Important?

A robust R&I system is vital for Ukraine's post-war recovery and economic resilience. LUKE fosters collaboration, pools resources, and supports integration of the Horizon Europe-associated countries into the European Research Area (ERA).


