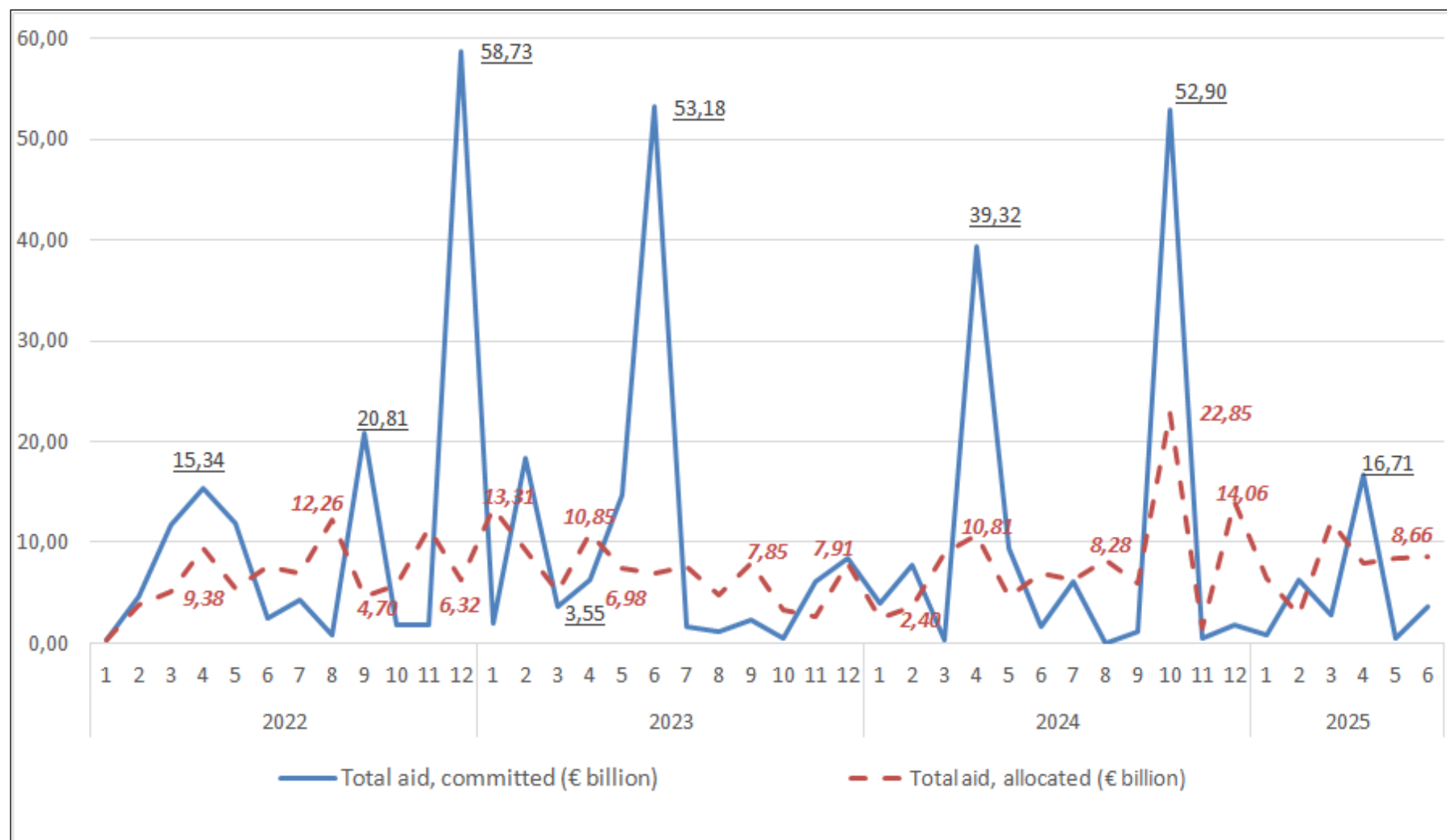


# International Aid to Ukraine during the War: the Role of Europe and the Baltic Countries in Supporting Sustainability and Well-Being

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## Dynamics of support: total commitments and allocations by month, February 2022 - June 2025 (*billion Euros*)

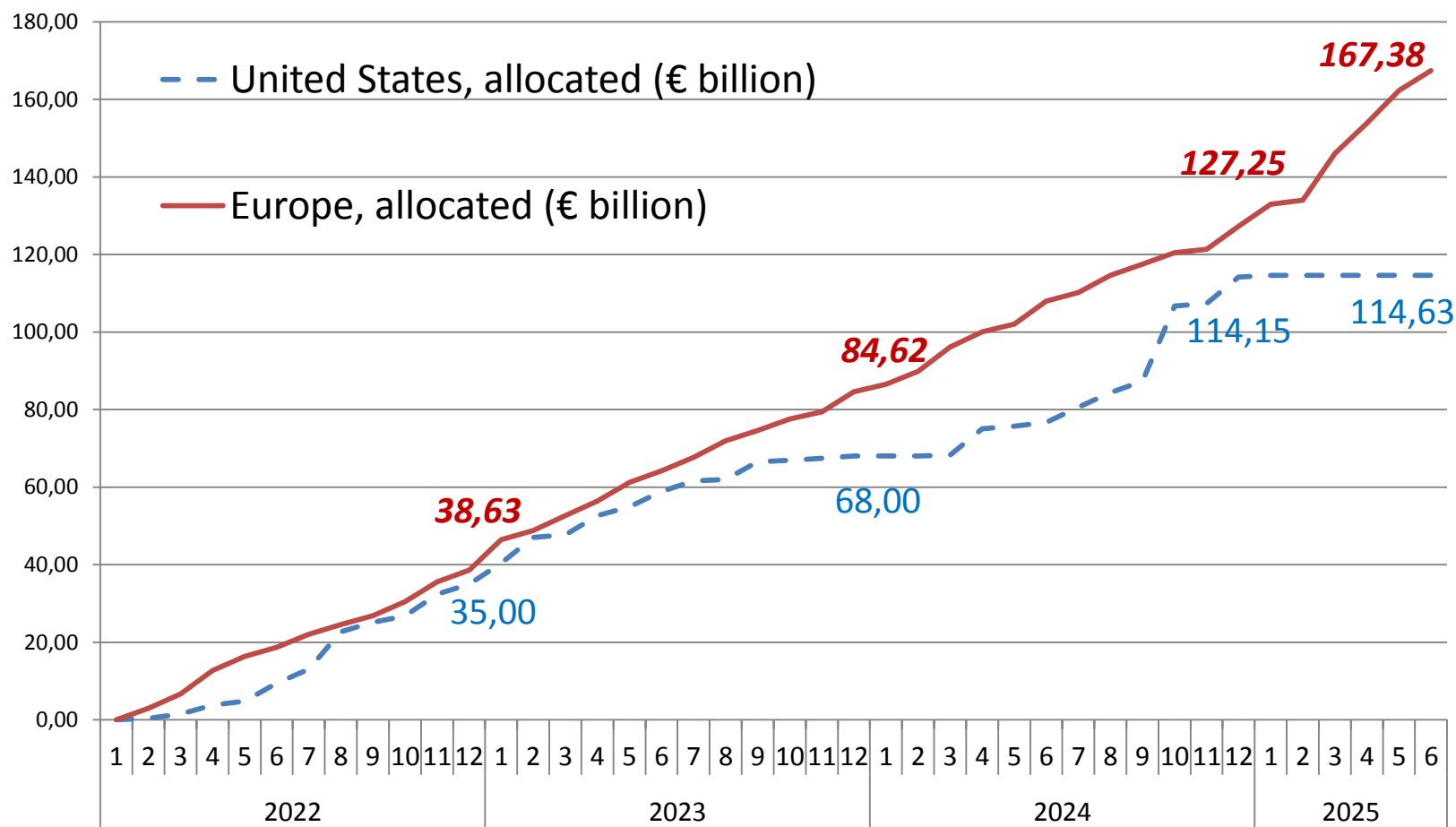
