Dear Colleagues

IAP for Health is committed to improving health worldwide. Millions of people, especially in developing countries, do not have access to conventional medical care. **Health in All Policies** (HiAP) is a collaborative approach that integrates and articulates health considerations into policymaking across sectors to improve the health of all communities and people.

With this in mind, IAP for Health is launching a project chaired by the Chinese Academy of Engineering to collect the best global practices in HiAP, those intersectorial practices and measures that have good health effects.

**We are now calling for member academies to nominate interested participants to sit on the Steering Committee of the project.**

Participants will:

- provide technical and strategic advice to the IAP in relation to this call
- guide the collection and review of cases that will be sought from the IAP member academies in their own countries
- be involved in bringing the call to the attention of relevant policy, research and community networks and thereby encourage participation in the process

Participants should preferably have experience in coordinating health policies and health management and of course anyone who has ever had any experience in HiAP would be perfect

It is the aim of the project to subsequently propose strategic suggestions, basic guiding principles and initiatives on promoting HiAP according to the experiences and lessons from the case studies received and from evidence based research.


