The paper must be up to a maximum of 15 pages, must be prepared in **Microsoft Word Office** Editor, (.doc format) and must be submitted by the hard copy and in electronic form. All margins of the paper sheet A4 are 3 cm. Font - TimesNewRomanSy - 12 pt, single spaced and indentation - 1.
